## Alternative Transportation from ABQ Support to Santa Fe:

- 1) Sandia Shuttle: (\$33+tax one way) ABQ to/from hotels in Santa Fe, including the Eldorado-reservations required
- 2) Rail Runner Train – bus #250 is free from ABQ to the train station and the Rail Runner train service to Santa Fe is \$10 one way. From the Santa Fe station there is free bus service (with your Rail runner ticket) to local points in Santa Fe
